Questions/Answers Document #2

1.) We understand the project requires management and daily supervision of a California Registered Civil Engineer (PE) and resident inspection is required to oversee and document construction activities. Is the onsite resident inspector required to be a registered PE, or can the inspector be under direct supervision of the project manager who is a registered PE and the engineer of record?

The Resident Inspector is not required to be a PE, but must be hired by the consultant, and have qualifications and previous work experience as an inspector, and will work under the direct supervision of the resident engineer.

2.) What is the name of the surveying firm that is currently preparing the basemap?

3.) Is the consultant required to conduct an environment review to conform with CEQA or NEPA or is this being addressed separately by Blue Lake Springs Mutual Water Company?
