Message to our Shareholders,

On Thursday February 18, Blue Lake Springs Mutual Water Company received a notification from Calaveras County Water District that Disinfection By-Products testing on their surface water exceeded the Maximum Contaminant Level for Haloacetic Acids for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2020.

As many of you know, our Mutual Water Company purchases water from CCWD to serve half of our water system.

We are required by the State Water Resources Control Board to test for Disinfection By-Products including Haloacetic Acids. Tests taken by Blue Lake Springs Mutual Water Company on December 21, 2020, and February 3, 2021, **did not** exceed the Maximum Contaminant Level for any Disinfection By-Product including Haloacetic Acids.

This notification is given to assure our shareholders that the water you are drinking meets all California State requirements.
